


 Cross breeding with autochthonous breeds (Buša and Slavonian-Syrmian Podolian)

 coastal (from Istria to Dubrovnik) regions


 Never reached larger proportion in cattle population





The number of lactations (305-d) and the average milk yield




Average fat and protein content in standard lactation



 8000 kg milk yield
 4.00% fat and
 3.45% protein content

 Current population is too small

 Current population is stabile
 The breed is recomended for farmers specialised for milk products in areas with lower feed production
