Negotiated procedure



- ≤ 15,000 €: EFSA invites min. 1 candidate
- ≤ 60,000 €: EFSA invites min. 3 candidates + must invite those expressing interest via EFSA website
- ≤ 139,000 €: EFSA invites min. 5 candidates + must invite those expressing interest via EFSA website



Our TASKING GRANTS enable our valued Article 36 partners to support us in our day-to-day scientific

This new type of grant is different because EFSA specifies the process or expertise required rather than Article 36 organisations proposing a specific project. EFSA focuses the tasking grants on these

- Establish working processes to allow EFSA to meet the requirements of new legislation Example: safety assessment of novel foods and traditional foods from third countries-
- Get expertise not available in EFSA to fulfil a specific mandate/task. Example: expertise on whole genome sequencing of zoonotic microorganisms-
- Develop guidance or methodologies. Example: drafting of new guidance on endocrine disruptors in pesticides-

- A long-term, multiannual partnership with EFSA.
- . The chance to work on the frontline of food safety risk assessment in Europe
- Mutually beneficial exchange of expertise and knowledge


